Our committees, all staffed by our wonderful volunteers, have worked hard this year. Here are some highlights (full details in the annual report).

Book and Periodicals Council: We had the opportunity to attend 5 learning sessions.

Budget: We've allocated \$1000 for translating our webpages into French.

Bulletin: We published three issues and welcomed a new managing editor on board.

Communications: We continue to actively reach out to our sister organizations to spread the word about events and achievements.

Conference: We had over 100 people register this year!

Ewart-Daveluy Award: Enid Zafran was awarded the Ewart-Daveluy in 2023.

ICRIS: We're working with our fellow societies on an international indexers website and on indexing the *Indexer*.

Incorporation: We officially incorporated as a not-for-profit on 26 September 2023.

Lending Library: We've had amazing generosity from members, allowing us to build our collection.

Membership: We currently have 125 members.

Mentorship: Facing a lack of mentors this time last year, we made a comeback with numerous people stepping up as volunteer mentors this year.

MIGs: We have 3 member-run groups currently active.

NIRC: Our website is an excellent resource for people contemplating a midlife career change to indexing.

Outreach: We awarded two bursaries this year, hosted booths at two outside events, sent out 102 letters to publishers, and have given presentations on indexing to 3 outside groups.

Regional Groups: We hosted 20 regional chats this year on top of our bi-monthly national chats.
